



CT Georgia Alumni Group Legacy Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a current graduating senior at Cass Technical High School, in good-standing
- Must have a college acceptance letter from a Georgia-based HBCU submitted with application
- Must be planning to attend the HBCU in the Fall-2025 semester
- Must have a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.50 or higher
- Must commit to remain engaged with the CT-Georgia Alumni Group Legacy Program (minimum of one year; monthly interaction) under the Mentorship Program by completing the mentorship application using this link <https://form.jotform.com/Trianglesocietyct/ct-ga-alumni-legacy-mentorship-app>

Application Requirements

- a.** Submit an essay answering the (4) required questions.

In an essay of 1,000 words or less, detail your responses to the following questions:

1. What do you want your legacy to be as a Cass Tech graduate?
2. What do you plan to do beyond education to solidify your goal?
3. Do you have any community service projects? If yes, please describe your involvement.
4. How will this Legacy Scholarship support your educational and leadership path forward?

- b.** Provide a headshot photo.

c. Provide a 3–6-minute video answering the (3) required questions.

In a 3-6-minute video answering the following questions:

1. (In 1-2 minutes or less) In order for us to get to know you better, introduce yourself and share something about yourself, not currently reflected in your application.
2. (In 1-2 minutes or less) Please explain why you feel you deserve this scholarship.
3. (In 1-2 minutes or less) Describe a significant challenge you overcame and how it impacted your academic pursuits.

d. Provide a copy of your acceptance letter to the Georgia HBCU you will be attending.

Application Submission Dates: April 28, 2025, through May 16, 2025

Application Deadline: May 16, 2025

2025-26 Scholarship Awards

Awardees: Two Recipients (2025-2026)

Year 1: Awardee #1 and Awardee #2: \$1,000 per Awardee

- Fall 2025 scholarship to be utilized for verifiable costs associated with tuition, books or housing the first year.

Years 2, 3 and 4: On-going Scholarship Support (2026-2027-2028)

- \$250 provided to the student IF an unweighted 2.75 GPA is maintained and student must maintain enrollment in the HBCU.
- Awardee(s) must remain engaged with the CT-GAG Legacy Group in order to remain eligible for the annual on-going scholarship support award. This includes attending a minimum of (1) CT-GAG Legacy Group event annually.
- Award will be paid directly to the HBCU college or university by September 1st of the award years if both bullets above (unweighted 2.75 GPA and CT-GAG engagement) have been achieved.

Scholarship winners to be announced by June 1, 2025, and distributions to awardees' university or college by September 1, 2025.
